Part A: Answer ONE question:

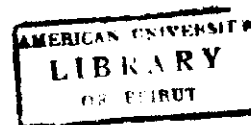
- I. "One hour of justice excels a thousand months of devotion". (Emir Bashir II, inscription at Beittedine).
