- I. Answer very briefly the following questions (3 5 lines):

 - 4. What is the basic dilemna within Gilgamesh?
 - 5. What is the basic urge in Odysseus when the epic opens and for what reason?

 - 1. Discuss with examples fifth century Athens as we have met it in <u>Oedipus the King, The Apology</u> and <u>The Peloponnesian War</u> (the concept of the <u>Polis</u>, the sense of crisis, the vision of Man, etc.)
