Part I Short Answer Questions

- Define the following terms and provide an example where it is relevant: (18 pts)
 Natural Selection, Standard (dialect), dyslexia
- 2. Hubert says, 'My sister Melba never eats any green vegetables.' (P.S. Answer does not require explanation) (6 pts)
 - a. Does this entail or presuppose that Melba would not eat spinach if it were offered to her?
 - b. Does this entail or presuppose that Hubert has a sister?
- 3. What's the difference between the relationship of (ia) and (ib) on the one hand, and the relationship between (iia) and (iib) on the other? Explain briefly. (5 pts)
 - i. a. Mary used to swim a mile daily.
 - b. Mary no longer swims a mile daily.
 - ii. a. After Hans painted the walls, Pete installed the cabinets.
 - b. Hans painted the walls.
- 4. The following are some popular myths about slang. Explain what about them is misconceived from the viewpoint established in class discussions on the topic. (10 pts)
 - a. Only young people use slang.
 - b. There are languages that have no slang.
- 5. Identify one metaphorical expression in the following sentence, then indicate its literal meaning and the appropriateness of its extension to the context of use. (5pts)
 - De Gaulle, father of the Fifth Republic, used to cite France's prodigious number of cheeses.
- 6. The following utterances were made either by Broca's aphasics or Wernicke's aphasics. Explain briefly why you think which utterance is made by which type of aphasic. (8pts)
 - a. yes, I, uh, can't hill all of my way. I can't talk all of the things I do, and part of the part I can go alright, but I can't tell from the other people.
 - b. Lower Falls, uh, Maine, uh, paper. Four hundred tons a day! And, uh, sulphur machines, and, uh, eight hours, uh, no! twelve hours, fifteen hours, uh, workin', uh, workin', workin'!

- 8. For each of the following excerpts name a (Gricean) maxim that has been violated and explain how. What is the intended meaning in each case? (7 pts)
 - (a) A: Did you get hold of Carl yet? B: I tried to call him yesterday.
 - (b) In an American Courtroom
 - A: Please state the location of your right foot immediately prior to impact.
 - B: Immediately before impact, my right foot was located at the end of my right leg.
