You can use the illustrations you have identified to help you locate specific aspects of the Story of various successive Cities of Beirut.

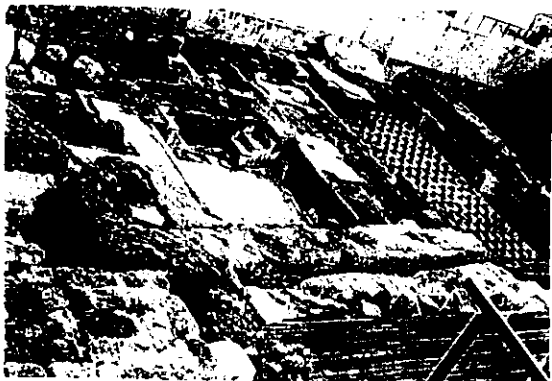




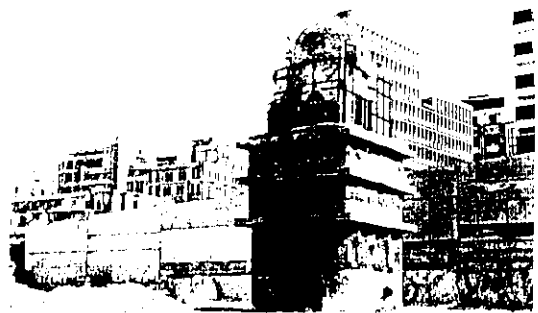

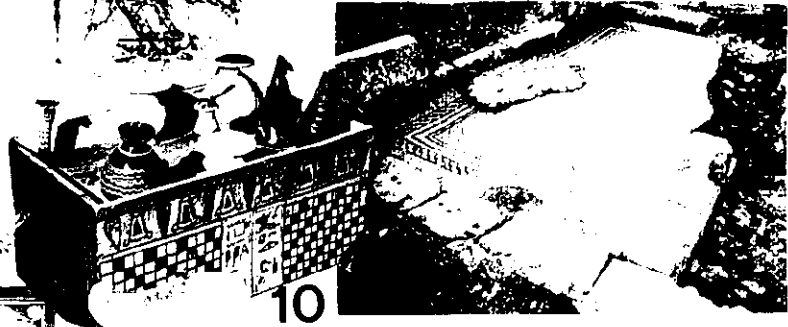
