## BEIRUT: PAST INTO FUTURE? ARCHAEOLOGY in the CENTER of URBAN RECONSTRUCTION

- The process of archaeological excavation carefully removes cultural heritage remains, context by context, removing mobile artefacts and samples and plotting and recording all features and structures. It replaces the site on the ground by archaeological records and site archives. These can lead to full visual reconstruction and presentation in several different media and contexts.
- What are the arguments for or against preservation in situ of archaeological remains in the Beirut city center? Try and present rational and archaeologically informed arguments, carefully weighing the relative importance of buried or excavated remains, standing historical buildings within the context of an urban center under development and reconstruction.
- Imagine the Beirut City Center integrating the diverse information gained during excavations, presenting it to the public in an interesting and comprehensible way, and also adding value to other urban activities practiced in an urban center, such as commerce and tourism.
