

- 1. The theme of isolation is a prominent and recurring one in Victorian literature. Explore this theme in any three of the following writers: Carlyle, Mill, Arnold, Pater, Shaw.
- 2. Discuss the treatment of evil in the works of three of the following authors: Browing, Pater, Wilde, Shaw.
- 3. The clash between science and religion dominates Tennyson's <u>In Memoriam</u>. Explore Tennyson's treatment of this theme in depth, then discuss at least two other works that treat this same problem.
- 4. In the <u>Importance of Being Earnest</u>, Wilde makes great fun of Victorian high-seriousness and of his own earlier works.

  Explain in detail how he does this.
