- 1. The spiritual crisis is very much a part of Victorian literature. Explore this crisis as it appears in the works of at least three of the following writers: Carlyle, Mill, Tennyson, Arnold, Newman.
- 2. Discuss the treatment of evil in Pater and Wilde.
- 3. Browning in "Andrea del Sarto" stated that "a man's reach should exceed his grasp, / Or what's a heaven for." What did he mean by this? Choose any other two writers and explore whether they agreed with him or not.
- 4. What is Shaw's attitude towards money in <u>Mrs. Warren's Profession</u>? Compare it with Browning's and Wilde's. What are the differences and similarities? Refer to any other Victorian authors of your choice.
- 5. Explore the attitude of Arnold, Shaw and Browning towards love and marriage. Bring in Wilde if you wish.
