## Time Allowed: 2 Hours

Choose <u>TWO</u> of the following essay questions and write for 60 minutes on each. Your essays should be well-organized and written in good English.

- 1. Discuss the theme of seriousness vs. triviality in Pope's The Rape of the Lock and Byron's Don Juan. Why is one a Neo-classical poem and the other Romantic? (If you choose this topic, do not choose nos. 3 or 6 as well.)
- 2. Dejection is a topic that several poets addressed this semester. Discuss the treatment of this topic by Gray, Wordsworth, Coleridge and Shelley.
- 3. <u>Gulliver's Travels</u> and <u>Don Juan</u> are both satires. What do they satirize? Explore. (If you choose this question, do not choose no. 1 as well.)
- 4. Explore the theme of the supernatural world in Shelley, Wordsworth and Keats.
- 5. The negative attitude to age is typical of much Romantic poetry. Explore the treatment of age in three Romantic poets of your choice.
- 6. What are the main characteristics of Neo-classical literature? Show how they manifest themselves in Pope, Swift, and Johnson.
- 7. Explore Wordsworth's shifting attitude to Nature, then compare and contrast it with that of Coleridge.
