- 1. Give derivations for <u>four</u> of the following sentences, in each instance starting with the deep structure and then indicating the effects of the relevant transformations. For ambiguous sentences, draw two different trees.
  - a. Did you know that Jeremy started the car rolling down the valley?
  - b. There appears to be a problem in the Marketing Department..
  - c. Inspector Fallon believes the thief that ran away from the police last night to be armed and dangerous.
  - d. Sally threatened the man with a stick.
  - e. Was it made clear to every soldier that flying planes might be dangerous.
  - f. It surprised Nora that it was clear that Natalie persuaded May to be interviewed by MTV.


## 2. Consider the following pairs of sentences:

- a. i. I haven't met your mother, and James has n't either.
  - ii. I haven't met your mother, and neither has James.
- b. i. John lost his wallet at the park, and Sami did too.
  - ii. John lost his wallet at the park, and so did Sami.
- A. Draw deep structure trees for the sentences above.
- B. Formulate rules that will generate these sentences from the deep structures.

## 3. Consider the following sentences:

- a. A man anxious to please his employers should wear new ties more often.
- b. The apples on the kitchen table were eaten by the boys.
- c. The two girls dancing to the music are my friends.
- d. The thief arrested by the police last night has been identified as the downtown sleepwalker.

Write down the deep structure of each Subject NP in the sentences above and formulate a rule to generate the surface structures from the corresponding deep structures.
